Minutes from June 3rd, 2010 Meeting

Hill City Area Chamber of Commerce met on June 3, 2010 at 6pm in the Community Room of City Hall.

Those present at the meeting were: Tina Harcey, Hank Berg, Lisa Anderson, Joell Miranda, Tami Meyer, Jessie Ahonen, Janet Hatfield, Tom Fasteland and Dave & Bambi Lange.

The secretary's report was given, motion to accept the minutes was made by Lisa Anderson, second by Hank Berg, motion passed.

The treasurer's report was given. There is about \$4,500.00 in the account after the second half of making the buttons was paid. Bills paid at the meeting were: Lake Country Power, Roadside (for Easter egg hunt), Kim Niles for maintaining Chamber website and yearly rental on post office box. Leaving the Chamber with a balance of about \$4,200. Bambi Lange made a motion to accept treasurer's report, motion second by Hank Berg, motion passed.

Tami Meyer stated that so far 6 flower barrels have been spoken for. Three by boy scouts in Veterans Park; 2 in Bear Park & 1 by church signs by Roadside corner for Kids Plus. Bambi Lange stated she will plant the ones on both ends of town by 'Welcome to Hill City' signs.

Lisa Anderson had tickets to hand out for selling for the Chamber fund raiser raffle which will be held on June 19, 2010. There are 200 tickets for cost of \$20.00 each (approx. half the money will be given out in prize money the other half will go to Chamber for 4th of July expenses). Persons buying tickets do not need be present at drawing to win. If you would like any tickets you may contact Lisa Anderson or other Chamber members.

It was also decided for that day Chamber will sell a pulled pork plate with chips at Mikes Uptown Liquor.

Bill Klennert was not at our meeting to answer questions concerning the upcoming softball tournament the weekend of June 26-27. It was decided the Chamber would sell pulled pork sandwiches and hot dogs with chips, cheap candy, water,

Gatorade, pop, coffee and cookies. A sign-up sheet was sent around at the meeting to sign up to work at the booth and to donate food toward the sale those days. We will have at least 2 people work per shift, working 2 hour shifts in the concession stand. We still need more people to sign up to work in our concession booth for that weekend. We will ask Shirley Spenser if we may use her little grill like we have the last couple years to grill the hot dogs. Dave Lange will contact the Snowmobile Club or Fire Dept about using their portable concession stand for that weekend.

Next item we discussed was upcoming 4th of July events.

Buttons have all been printed and are available in local businesses for sale.

Tina Harcey is working on contacting local businesses about advertising on tee shirts that we will have available for the sale on the 4th. The design on the shirts will be similar to what is on our buttons. Businesses have till June 10th to commit to advertising on the shirts.

Lisa Anderson is working on getting preliminary copy of the flyer done so can get them out into the community.

Talked about what we wanted to sell at the Chamber booth on Sat. and Sun. Possibilities were: cotton candy(if there are people willing to make it), popcorn, pulled pork sandwich plate on Sat. – possibly just pulled pork sandwiches on Sun., hot dogs both days, fruit kabobs, slices of pie and ice cream on Sat. Please bring ideas to next meeting. Also t-shirts, maybe balloons. We need people willing to work at the booth on Sat. and Sun. to make it work.

Pie auction was discussed, the baton twirlers will donate 20 pies, Chamber will donate the other pies, we decided no more than 40 pies will be auctioned. If you wish to bake a pie for the pie auction please let Bambi Lange know. There will be a sign-up sheet for pies at the next meeting.

Dave Lange will contact a few people concerning being grand marshals for the parade.

Other items concerning the 4th were tabled till our meeting next week.

Discussed having the parade go the full length of Lake Avenue so there would be more room for people to view the parade from, so it is not so crowded along the 2 blocks of Lake Avenue. Possibly having parade line up on Lone Ave. going then

onto Pine Street to Lake Avenue by lake and going all the way up Lake Avenue from Hill Lake.

Tom Fastland stated that National Night Out will be sometime mid-August, depending on when Lake Avenue is done with construction.

The Chamber will be meeting weekly till the 4th of July. We will only talk about items that pertain to upcoming events that are taking place between now and the 4th of July.
